The Alaska Online Public Notice System allows the public to search or browse public notices, save searches, and to subscribe based on search criteria.

## Frequently Asked Questions about the Alaska Online Public Notice System

### How can I search for public notices?

There are a number of search fields available. You can enter search criteria in as many or as few of the search fields as you would like. Available search fields include:

- Status
- Title
- Full Text - *performs an intelligent search of the notice body*
- Department
- Category
- Sub-Category
- Location(s) - *press [Ctrl] to select more than one location*
- Project # - *Project or regulation # relating to the notice*
- Event/Deadline Start/End Date
- Publish Start/End Date
- Archive Start/End Date

Once you have entered your desired search criteria, click the "Search" button below the search fields. Your search results will appear in the panel to the right. Click on any search result and the notice will open in the "View" tab.

### How can I be notified when new public notices are published?

You can subscribe via e-mail or RSS feed. In the "Search" tab click "Subscribe" on the bottom and select "all notices." You may select RSS and/or daily email notifications. Additionally, you can choose to subscribe to only those notices that match specific search criteria (see above list).
