Division of Oil and Gas
Bid openings for Cook Inlet and Alaska Peninsula Area-wide 2018 competitive oil and gas lease sales are scheduled to be held May 9, 2018.

Hilcorp
Recently approved plans of development for Ivan River, Lewis River, and Pretty Creek units call for continued gas production and field analyses for further development.

Doyon-CIRI
Partnering to drill Totchaket 1 exploratory well this summer in Nenana basin. Well location identified from 2017 3D seismic.

Division of Oil and Gas
Received one exploration license application for the Nenana Area.

Hilcorp/Harvest Alaska
Planning to lay subsea gas pipeline under Cook Inlet from offshore Tyonek gas platform to west side of the inlet. A twin subsea gas pipeline currently part of the Cook Inlet Gas Gathering System will be converted to carry oil to Nikiski, allowing decommissioning of the Drift River oil terminal.

Hilcorp
Proposal to terminate Stump Lake Unit approved by Division of Oil and Gas

Furie
Signed gas supply agreement with Municipal Light & Power.

Furie
Planning workover of Kitchen Lights 3 well, to include adding perforations in Beluga Formation. Planning to complete Kitchen Lights 1A well and anticipate gas production by mid-June. Evaluating drilling plans for KLU 6 well.

Aurora Exploration
Recently acquired interests in Nicolai Creek Unit from Aurora Gas, LLC. Planning to drill 900' directional well targeting Beluga and Upper Tyonek sands prior to January 2019.

Hilcorp
Plan to drill five offshore wells from Steelhead platform into McArthur River field.

Cook Inlet Energy
Recently approved West McArthur River Unit plan of development calls for production enhancement, decline management, maximizing total recovery, and permitting Sabre exploration well.

Cook Inlet Energy
Recently approved Redoubt Unit plan of development calls for drilling well for pressure management water injection, fracture stimulation of up to three wells.

Hilcorp
Planning two to four new wells at Swanson River.

Hilcorp
Request to redefine and expand vertical boundaries of Ninilchik Beluga/Tyonek gas pool was approved by AOGCC.

Glacier Oil and Gas
Recently approved 53rd plan of development for North Fork Unit calls for improving infrastructure, monitoring and analyzing production from existing wells, optimizing production, and continuing development drilling.

Hilcorp
Planning to build Seaview pad near Anchor Point in mid-2018, following up on drilling of seven stratigraphic test wells in 2017.

Hilcorp
Applied to BOEM for permit to collect airborne gravity and magnetic data in lower Cook Inlet, May-July, 2018.
